Subject: Filling of vacant posts of JTS, STS and STS (NF) of IB (E)S.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to DGAIR letter No. 1/1/2009-SIII dated 15.10.2009, 24.12.2009 and 19.1.2010 on the subject noted above.

2. The sanction strength of IB(E)S as on 1.1.2010 is as under:-

4.	STS/ STS(Non-functional)	585 **
5.	JTS	721

**Senior Time Scale (Non-functional) is non-functional grade and the maximum number of posts in this grade shall be equal to 30% of Senior duty posts (i.e. all duty posts at the level of Senior Time Scale and above in the Cadre). The number of posts to be operated in the non-functional grade will be further limited to the number of posts available in STS.

2. DGAIR is requested to take following action in the matter of promotion of STS(Non-functional Grade), JTS to STS and AE to JTS:-

- (i) Necessary action for holding regular DPC for promotion from JTS to STS for the available vacancies.
- (ii) A complete proposal for conducting regular DPC for promotion from STS to STS(Non-functional) may be sent to the Ministry.
- (iii) Send the revised eligibility list of AEs and upto date CRs of the candidates so that UPSC could be requested to convene DPC of JTS grade of IB(E)S at the earliest.
